The ROTOCONTROL DT-340 digital label finishing machine with an integrated Domino N610i label press will be featured in ROTOCONTROL's new headquarters and demo center in Siek, Germany.

An open architecture design provides easy operator access to the web and integrated modules, for increased efficiencies in operation/web handling and movement during production.
